**Eligibility:** College bilingual students working towards certification in bilingual Education – junior status as of September 1, 2009.

The Fresno Madera chapter of the California Association for bilingual Education and the California Association for Secondary bilingual Education will award scholarships in the amount of \$1,000.00 each to college students who have attained junior status as of September 1, 2009 and are working towards bilingual education certification. Winning students must present documentation attesting to their enrollment in a college or university with a GPA of 3.0 minimum. All required information must accompany the application. Missing documentation will disqualify the applicant. Check to make sure the following items are included.

- 3. \_\_\_ Two letters of recommendation (to include a university professor/BCLAD Coordinator)
- 4. \_\_\_ An essay of approximately 250 words entitled “Biliteracy: Creating a World for Better Understanding.” (Please write the same essay in your home language and in English and submit on separate paper – typed.)
